Call for Proposals

Saluki Summer Bridge is a FREE, two-week residential academic enrichment program designed to help first-year students transition and adjust to college life. Students participate in non-credit bearing college-level courses, study skills workshops, study labs, and campus resource seminars that will help them prepare for their first semester at SIUC.

We are seeking faculty, staff, doctoral and graduate students to teach engaging college-level short courses on a variety of subjects to incoming freshman. Each course session meets for fifty minutes, five days a week **July 15th through July 25th**. Upon the completion of the program, instructors will be paid a one-time \$500 stipend. Suggested topics are listed below, similar topics across disciplines may be accepted:

- Humanitarianism and Global Justice
- Race and Hip Hop
- Communication Across Cultures
- Creative Research and Writing
- Leadership Development
- Aspects of Engineering and Technology
- Forensic Science
- Information and Electronic Systems Technology
- Medical Preparation: Human Anatomy

- Courses should be designed for college-level freshman
- Proposals should include a general summary of the course including learning objectives, themes to be examined, and sample assignments, syllabus, and a final project
